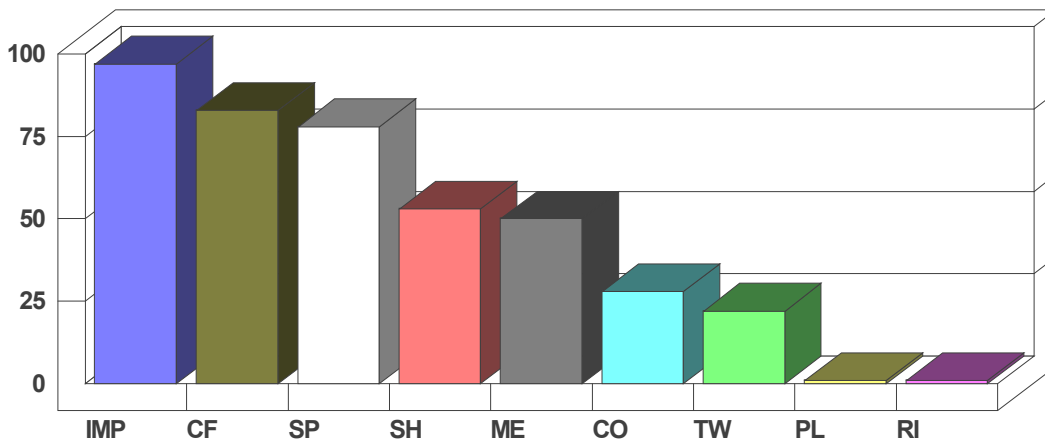

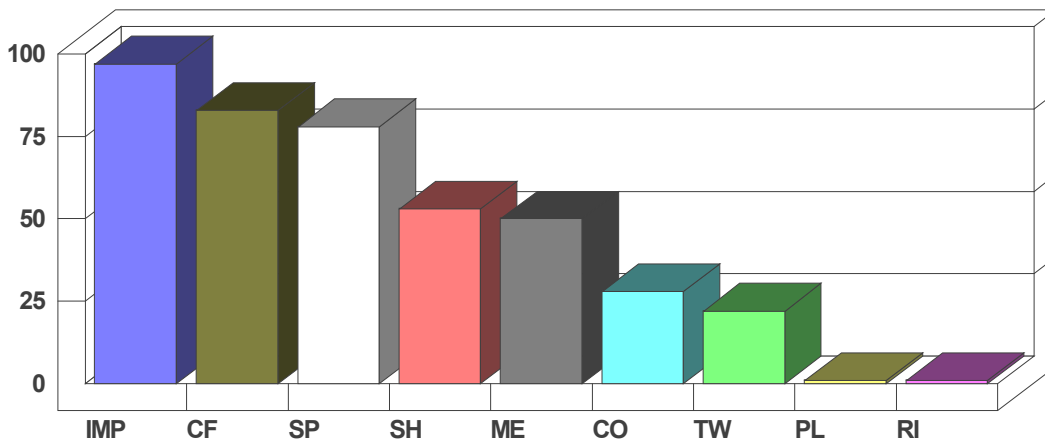
A good appointment will need someone who can resist social distraction in the interest of meeting urgent job demands.

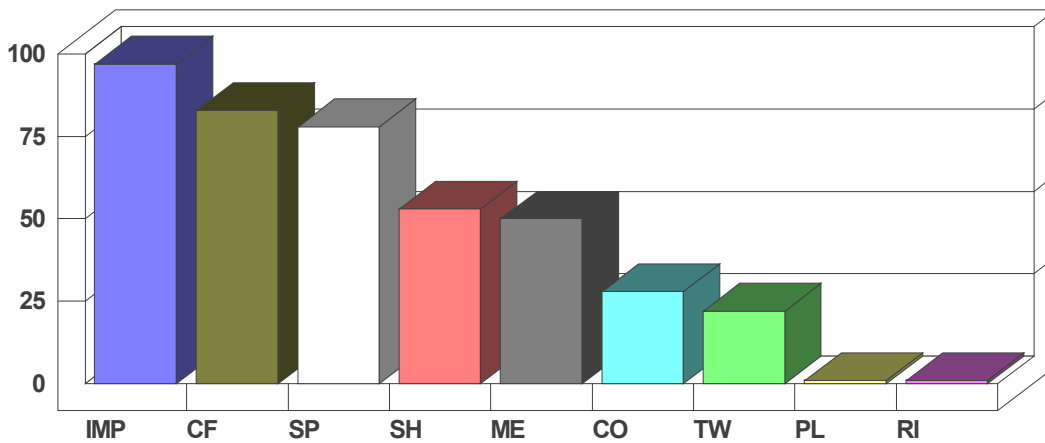
